














Slow summer, acrylic und spray paint on paper, each 56 cm x 76 cm, 2017









Iron curtain acrylic und spray paint on canvas each 100 cm x 120 cm, 2011-2019






Felix Malnig: D (Detroit)

Video-loop, 6:23 minutes, 2009




Felix Malnig: Joyride


